



# Clyst Honiton Neighbourhood Development Plan INFORMATION STATEMENT

## Referendum: Thursday 23 January 2025

### Information Statement

A neighbourhood planning referendum will be held for the Clyst Honiton Neighbourhood Development Plan on Thursday 23 January 2025.

The question asked in the referendum will be:

- **Do you want East Devon District Council to use the Neighbourhood Plan for Clyst Honiton to help it decide planning applications in the neighbourhood area?"**

The referendum area for the Neighbourhood Plan is the majority of the parish of Clyst Honiton, excluding strategic development areas in the north and east. This is also the area covered by the Neighbourhood Plan and is shown on the map overleaf.

A person is entitled to vote in the referendum if, on Thursday 23 January 2025,

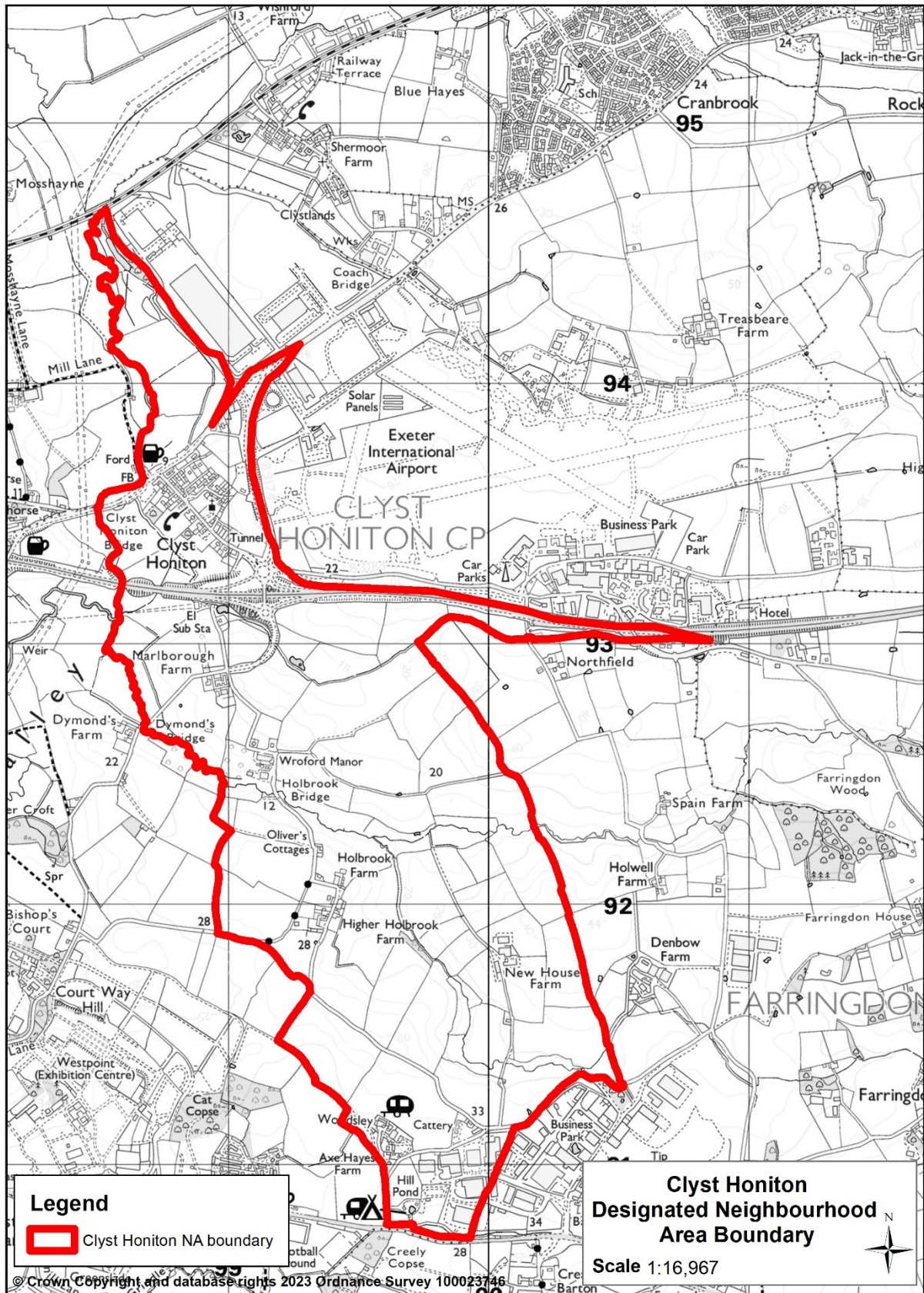
- they are entitled to vote in a local government election in the referendum area; and
- their qualifying address for the election is in the referendum area. (A person's qualifying address, in relation to a person registered in the register of electors, is the address in respect of which they are entitled to be registered.)

The referendum expenses limit that will apply in relation to the referendum is £2378.46.

The number of persons entitled to vote in the referendum by reference to which the limit has been calculated is 279.

The referendum will be conducted in accordance with procedures which are similar to those used at local government elections.
