I also note that this issue has been raised in some of the representations.</p> <p>Is the District Council continuing to work to the timetable to produce this Plan as set out in paragraph 8 of the Local Development Scheme (July 2025)?</p> | <p>Yes, we can confirm that the District Council is currently working to the timetable for preparation of the emerging East Devon Local Plan (2020 to 2042) as set out in paragraph 4.2 of the Local Development Scheme (LDS) that was recommended for adoption by Strategic Planning Committee and Cabinet in July 2025.</p> <p>Please note the published document is dated October 2025, reflecting when it was subsequently <a href="#">adopted by Council</a>:-</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <a href="#">east-devon-lds-october-2025.pdf</a> (see paragraph 4.2)</li> </ul> <p>In line with this, the Plan is currently out to its second and final Regulation 19 stage consultation, which commenced in late Autumn 2025 and closes 26<sup>th</sup> January 2026, and we are continuing to aim for submission in Spring 2026.</p> |
