

UK Shared Prosperity Fund Outputs and Outcomes

East Devon District Council was allocated £1,796,363 of UK Shared Prosperity Funding (UKSPF) and £854,298 of Rural England Prosperity Funding (REPF) between 2022/23 and 2024/25 under the [UKSPF Programme](#). The below table provides a list of the outputs and outcomes achieved from across the funding period.
