Election of a Town Councillor Honiton Town Council St. Michael`s ward

1. An Election is to be held of One Town Councillor for Honiton Town Council, St. Michael`s ward.

3. Nomination papers must be delivered to the Returning Officer, Blackdown House, Border Road, Honiton, EX14 1EJ on any day after the date of this notice but no later than 4pm on Friday, 20th February 2026.
4. If any election is contested the poll will take place on Thursday, 19th March 2026.
5. Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Blackdown House, Border Road, Honiton, EX14 1EJ by 5pm on Wednesday, 4th March 2026.
6. Applications for a Voter Authority Certificate or an Anonymous Elector`s Document valid for this must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Blackdown House, Border Road, Honiton, EX14 1EJ by 5pm on Wednesday, 11th March 2026.
7. Applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Blackdown House, Border Road, Honiton, EX14 1EJ by 5pm on Wednesday, 11th March 2026.
8. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election applied for on grounds of physical incapacity, where that physical incapacity occurred after 5 pm on Wednesday, 11th March 2026, must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Blackdown House, Border Road, Honiton, EX14 1EJ by 5pm on Thursday, 19th March 2026.
