

## EDDC UKSPF Spend 2022-25

The UK Shared Prosperity Fund (UKSPF) is a UK government programme that provides funding for local growth and investment. UKSPF was originally funded for a three-year period between 2022/23 and 2024/25, with East Devon receiving an allocation of £1,796,363. East Devon was allocated an additional £854,298 through the [Rural England Prosperity Fund](#) (REPF) over a two year period (2023/24 to 2024/25).

This document provides the amount spent on each UKSPF and REPF projects in the 2022-2025 period.
