## Local Green Spaces Assessment

### Name of space: Millennium Green, Ottery St Mary (Policy NP5(i))

#### Description of space:

Extensive POS located on both sides of the banks of the River Otter near St Saviours Bridge with a walkway bridge crossing provided by OSMTC.

POS offers footpath access on the west bank of River Otter down to Tipton St John, available for walkers & dog walkers with provision of pooper bins. Community use includes: Fire Engine festivals, Tar Barrels Night for Funfair and Bonfire (Nov 5<sup>th</sup>), music festivals, car boot sales, exhibitions, used by Scouting groups for activities (bridge building).
